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Keywords: maximum of 03 words, Arial font, size 11.

To submit your abstract, you must be registered for the event and have your payment confirmed (Registration: <https://oiagfortaleza.com/ingressos/eiaq>). The abstract must be sent to the email address oiag2026@gmail.com.

The text must fit within a maximum of 1 page, A4 size, with 3 cm margins on the right, left, top, and bottom. The title must be typed in capital letters, bold, using Arial font, size 12. All remaining text of the abstract (authors, authors' institutions, keywords, and abstract text) must be in Arial font, size 11.

Student contributions will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the event, and the **03 best undergraduate and graduate student contributions will be awarded at the end of the event.**

The deadline for abstract submission is **September 30, 2026**, and each event registration allows the online submission of up to **02 (two) abstracts**.

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The students contributions must be displayed on the poster boards set up in the EIAQ exhibition area on the morning of **October 17**. The authors responsible for the contributions must be present beside their posters during the poster session, according to the event program.

A numbered list of all contributions to be presented at the EIAQ will be available in the poster area. Identify the number assigned to your abstract and place your poster in the corresponding location.

Maximum poster dimensions: 0.90 m wide × 1.20 m high.
